

Digital Forensics Incident Response Plan Gap Assessment

1 Overview of the Service

NTT DFIR Consultants will collaborate with an organization's Information Technology (IT) and/or Security Operations Centre (SOC) teams to evaluate how incident response is currently handled when responding to security alerts, major incidents, and breaches.

2 Client Responsibilities

- (a) Point of contact: The Client will appoint a primary point of contact for NTT personnel to liaise with throughout the engagement to gather specific information (e.g. existing incident response plans and other IR-related material), schedule and attend workshops, and support the successful completion of the IR Gap Assessment. The primary method of communication will be email.
- (b) Required Materials: The Client will provide the materials reasonable requested by NTT.

3 Service Specific Operations

Task	Description
IR Plan Baseline	Conduct a remote workshop(s) with the client to run through their existing IR Plan and establish a baseline
Peer Benchmark	Conduct a rapid peer benchmark using peer insights
Future State IR Plan	Define a high-level future state IR Plan in line with the client's wider security strategy, budget and resource constraints, threat landscape, and peers.
Gap Analysis	Conduct and document a gap analysis from the client's existing IR plan baseline, peer insights, and the agreed future state.
IR Gap Assessment Report	Define and document a final gap assessment report.

3.1 DFIR Retainer Hours

- (a) This section is out of scope for clients acquiring this service as a standalone offering.
- (b) NTT enables clients that have selected Gold and Platinum DFIR retainer packages to utilize unused retainer hours towards the deployment of this service. These clients can utilize this service anytime within their contracted term (up to the last 60 days) and are strongly encouraged to do so.
- (c) Gold clients can use no more than 50% of their unused retainer hours towards additional IR related services. The balance of unused hours must meet or exceed 40 hours to deploy this service.
- (d) Platinum clients can use 100% of their unused retainer hours towards this service. The balance of unused hours must meet or exceed 40 hours to deploy this service.

5 Billing

Standalone: Charges shall be based on a fixed fee for the work to be carried out, subject to the Limitations below, any additional hours shall be at NTT's current DIFR hourly rate. Any further investigation, remediation, or forensic activities that may be required will be charged separately as agreed via a new statement of work.

Utilizing Gold or Platinum Retainer Hours: A client can utilize their unused retainer hours as a means of payment for the service. A total of 40 hours will be deducted from the client's remaining DFIR retainer hours.

6 Limitations

- (a) The IR Gap Assessment will be carried out via remote means only and no onsite delivery will occur.
- (b) The IR Gap Assessment will not go beyond the identification and prioritization of identified gaps within a client's IR Response Plan.
- (c) The IR Gap Assessment will last no longer than 40 Hours of work billed in whole hour increments.
